Developing oracy and communication is pivotal to driving outstanding progress and attainment across the curriculum. The new Ofsted 'Common Inspection Framework' recognises the importance of using talk to accelerate and deepen learning in all subjects. **This 9-session programme** explores how to promote, develop and embed purposeful talk to enable students to successfully demonstrate their thirst for learning and students' metacognitive skills.
